There are a number of activities that are designated for specific age groups; they will be annotated with the following symbols:

- (F) Family Activity – Everyone may participate – Children 6 and under must be accompanied by an adult

- (T) Teens or ages 12+, 14+, 16+, or 18+ (Event will be marked accordingly, no exceptions allowed).
- (C) Children 10 and under (Event will be marked accordingly – please no exceptions).
- (\$) Per Person Fee

Parents and Grandparents are invited and encouraged to attend all events with their children and grandchildren. Many events have a participation age noted. Children under the minimum participation age may participate in the event or activity with an adult to assist them. Children under the age of 6 must be accompanied by an adult during any event.

Only adults may sign up children up for an event. Please include your membership number on all forms.
